5. **Read Hebrews 10:21-25.** How do you “*hold unswervingly to the hope*” of Jesus?
6. **Read Hebrews 10:32.** What are some things from your past that help your confidence to grow?
7. Do you find that it’s easy to forget about what God has done in your life?
8. **Read Psalm 3:3.** Have you ever felt like God has *lifted your head*? If so, share it. What was your response to God lifting your head?

Challenge:

There are two great ways to gain confidence:

1. Lock arms with each other (Hebrews 10:21-25)
2. Lock eyes on Jesus and remember (Hebrews 10:32)
