Core:

2. **Read Ephesians 6:14-18**. Take some time and discuss each of these pieces of armor and what the mean: (a) Breastplate of Righteousness (b) Shoes of Readiness that comes from the gospel of peace (c) Shield of Faith to extinguish the flames from the evil one (d) Helmet of Salvation (e) Sword of the Spirit.

3. Looking at this spiritual battle armor described in Ephesians 6, what do you think is the piece you use the most, and why?

4. Jim said, "Weapons and armor, on their own, can't do anything. Weapons locked in a box or armor hanging in the closet are irrelevant." What do you think are some of the reasons people won't arm and equip themselves for spiritual battle?

5. Jim talked about how we let our body control our emotions, and then the emotions control our minds, our minds then control our hearts, and finally, our hearts determine what's true (subjective to our circumstances). How can this spiritual armor fight this?

Challenge:
