## PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Recruit, train, schedule, and develop volunteers.
- Responsible for the stewardship of the Student Ministry Budget.
- Responsible for all administrative tasks and needs of the ministry – credit card reports, emails, communication with parents, tracking attendance, etc.
- Responsible to collaboratively work with the Student Ministry Support & Development Director, as well as other Flatirons Student Directors.
- Support, attend, and help the overall operation of the Denver Campus.

## SECONDARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for school and community outreach to students.
- Planning and executing camp experiences for Flatirons Students.
- Responsible for executing Flatirons Student Ministries community outreach events (e.g. – Flatirons Food Drive)
