

Group Overview:

Today we want students to discuss where they see Jesus meet them and provide for their basic needs and where they may feel like Jesus did not meet those needs. Picking up on conversation - encourage students to see Jesus where they do not. (i.e., A student says Jesus doesn't meet my needs of loving me... take mental notes and make a point to link up with that student with a special moment or message and Bible verse that shows them the TRUTH. Verses on Love, Purpose, Provision, Safety, etc.

Discussion Questions:

1. Have you ever had a moment where you felt overwhelmed by your emotions/feelings? What was that like?
2. Where have you felt that Jesus has met your basic needs? What are some needs you feel like Jesus has not met?
3. What do you run to (fish for) rather than spending time with Jesus?
4. How can you lean into Jesus this week for your needs? How can you support someone in your life this week? (Bring them their favorite snack or spend some quality time with them)

Prayer:

Make sure to take note on what your students say and pray for them as a group.
