Core:

- 2. Read Psalm 16:11.

- **4. Read Ecclesiastes 3:11**. What do you think it means that God has set eternity in the hearts of men?
- **5. Read Ecclesiastes 12:8.** Can you relate to Solomon's pursuit of pleasure and realizing what you were chasing after wasn't fulfilling? How so?
- 6. Read Matthew 13:44, Psalm 16:6, and Psalm 16:11 again.

Challenge:

Take some time each day this week, read through those verses again, and pray (and journal if you want) about where you feel God taking you, and what still needs to change in your life to line up with His good plan.
