Weekend Discussion Questions

November 7- 8, 2015

Community:

1. Which is your favorite part of your house, and why?
2. How would you describe your home life today (i.e., happy, stressful, angry, peaceful, etc.)?

Core:

1. Have you settled for *normal* where God says you can be *exceptional* in this life?
2. **Read: Matthew 7:24-27.** As Jim Burgen pointed out, Jesus tells us that how we weather the storms in life is based on what we're *putting into practice*. Where have you seen this truth in your life—and the lives of those around you?
3. What are some areas in your life where you believe that God's word is true and you *DO* put it into practice? Where don't put it into practice?
4. **Read: Mark 12:30.** When you think of loving God with all your *heart, soul, mind* and *strength*, which one is the hardest for you? What can you do to "exercise" that area of loving God?
5. **Read: Joshua 24:15.** "*But for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.*" Would you say that this describes your house? Why or why not?
6. Jim listed a handful of questions this past weekend. How would you answer them?
 - a) If you could sum up life at your house, what word or words would you use to describe your home?
 - b) What word do you wish described your home?
 - c) If you had that kind of a home what do you think that would give you?
 - d) What is standing in the way of you having those good things?
 - e) Would you be willing to look at the sections of your life to see if you would change to what Jesus says is right and true and better?

Challenge:

If you haven't already, take some time this week—thinking and meditating on this message—and then complete this mission statement as it stands in your home right now:

"As for me and my house we are..."
