Community:

1. What is the foundation of your “home”?
2. How would you describe the perfect household?

Core:

1. What is the difference between a *storm-free life* and a *storm-proof life*? Which one does Jesus promise
2. **Read: Job 31:1 and 31: 9-12.** Why does God take this issue so seriously? How does lust harm a man’s protection of his family?
3. How are you currently leading your homes within the roles that God has defined for both men and women? Does the way that you are doing this align with what God says is true and a better way to live? What needs to change?
4. **Read: Ephesians 5:22-25.** Why do you think the Biblical pattern for marriage works best? Why does it sound (and seem) so foreign in our culture today?
5. **Read: Titus 2:3-4.** What does it look like for a woman to be the queen of her home?
6. Are there areas in your life where you think you’re, maybe, smarter than God?
7. Where does pride show up the most in your life, and where does it lead to sin?
8. Men: What holds you back the most when it comes to submitting to Jesus?
Women: What holds you back the most when it comes to submitting to Jesus and your husband?
9. What needs to change this week in your home, and how are you going to take responsibility for it?

Challenge:

- **Men:** What is keeping you from being the warrior priest of your home? How are you the “door” that protects your family? Write down your answers and think about them daily for the next week. Take responsibility and make the changes where you need to.
- **Women:** What is holding you back from being the queen of your home? In what ways have you not accepted that responsibility? Write down your answers and think about them over the next week. Make the changes where you need to.
