Weekend Discussion Questions

February 1-2, 2014

Community:

1. Did you play sports when you grew up? Tell the group what sports and what position you played.
2. Tell the group about your greatest sports moment.

Core:

1. Jim said this weekend, “Just because you wear the uniform, doesn’t make you an actual player.” How does that relate to being husbands/wives/parents?
2. Read Luke 12:1. How would you define the word “hypocrisy”?
3. Why would Jesus tell us to “beware of...hypocrisy”?
4. Now read verse 2-3. What’s the way you picture this when you first read through the verses?
5. While those verses could speak to a day far in the future when we come face to face with Jesus, more likely it’s telling us that at some point all our small, seemingly insignificant decisions are going to pile up and suddenly be a mountain that can’t be ignored. How have you seen hundreds of small decisions pile up and create a very huge, obvious problem in either your life or the life of someone you know?
6. Now skip down to verses 17-19, and read about the man who spent his life acquiring more and more and tried to figure out what to do with it. Why is what this man is doing both wise and foolish at the same time?
7. Read verses 20-21. If you were told that you were going to die tonight, what thoughts would you have?
8. What do you think that it means to be “rich toward God”?
9. For men, being rich toward God means following Jesus’ commands...specifically, to follow Jesus, love your wife, and lead your family (similar things could be applied for wives, single guys, grandparents, etc.). What does it mean to follow Jesus? What does it mean to love your wife? What does it mean to lead your family?

Challenge:

1. What are a few ways you can become a better follower of Jesus?
2. What are a few ways you can become a better spouse or boyfriend/girlfriend?
3. What are a few ways you can become a better parent?
