The Male Leader Care and Program Coordinator supports Flatirons' Lafayette Students by intentionally coaching, developing, and pastoring male volunteer leaders to healthily and consistently engage with students through relational ministry. This includes creating systems and process for new leader onboarding, planning and facilitating weekly leader meetings, and creating and sustaining overall leader and program culture.

QUALIFICATIONS / CHARACTERISTICS

- Submits their life to God and the authority of his Word, and models a commitment to developing the character of Christ
- Exhibits a passion for students knowing Jesus
- Experience working with, mentoring, and leading students and teens
- Strong interpersonal skills - quick to empathy, focuses on conflict resolution, maintains confidentiality, high emotional intelligence, sets and keeps healthy boundaries
- Extremely relational - is filled up by spending time with people, manages multiple relationships at a time, has capacity for many shallow connections and deep relationships simultaneously
- Team work - welcomes feedback, contributes to building morale and connection amongst teams of people, puts success of team above own interest, "see the need, meet the need"
- Time management - balances individual and team responsibilities, shows initiative and strong work ethic, thrives under flexibility, is a self-starter

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan and execute aspects of weekly REV and CHAOS programs (may include leading stage games, and always includes leading a small group)
- Attend leader dinner after REV & leader lunch after CHAOS to build community and shared culture
- Identify and empower Key Leaders on each grade/gender team
- Monthly meetings with Key Leaders
- Meet one-on-one with all male leaders at least once a semester, manage and maintain consistent meeting schedule
- Plan, lead, and facilitate pre-program leader meetings
- Strategize creative and intentional ways of coaching and developing male leaders at different stages of life and spiritual maturity
- Create and provide monthly opportunities for male leaders to connect and build community
- Create, plan, and execute annual leader appreciation events
- Assist in equipping high-school student leaders in monthly check-in after REV
- Strategize and execute vision and support and discipleship of Student Captain leadership
- Attend and support Student Team at all-hands on deck events (camps, retreats, weekend event promotion, trainings, service projects, Easter & Christmas services, etc.)
