Weekend Discussion Questions

October 24- 25, 2015

Community:

1. What was the reason you first came to Flatirons?
2. Is there a certain song which means a lot to you because of what you have been going through? If so, what is it?

Core:

1. **Read: John 6:44-45.** What did God do, in and around you, to draw you to Jesus?
2. Are there ways that you try to create an *excellent environment* in your life so that people might be able to “bump into Jesus”? If so, how?
3. Where else (besides church) have you looked for hope? What’s been the result?
4. Since God rearranged the universe to provide a place for us to meet Jesus in church, why do you think it is important to create and maintain excellent environments?
5. **Read: Hebrews 10:23-25.** According to this scripture, what prepares us to not give up and to make a change in the world?
6. **Read: Acts 2:42.** In what ways can this example play out in your life right now?
7. When you feel guilt, how do you react to it? Do you use it as a wakeup call to change or do you beat yourself up over it? Why do you think you react either way?
8. **Read: Matthew 28:18-20.** What has God commanded every church to do? How can you respond to this command?
9. **Read: Mark 1:3.** How can you start doing what John the Baptist did—in order to help more people to “bump into Jesus”?

Challenge:

Think through your everyday life. Each day you get an opportunity to show someone who Jesus is; from the way you treat them...to the way you talk...to the way you treat others around you.

Over this next week, pay attention to ways that you *don't* create excellent environments for other people to see Jesus in (and around) you and look for ways to change. Examine your life for ways for *you* set up your day-to-day life to show others who Jesus really is—and work towards making adjustments that better represent Him.
