Weekend Discussion Questions

October 17-18, 2015

Community:

1. In what areas of your life are you a renegade?
2. In what ways do you think you are "gifted"?

Core:

1. What is significant about Jesus choosing to spend time with Zaccheus? What does that mean for you?
2. How is serving within the church or a partner ministry a part of your discipleship?
3. How does service mirror the way that Jesus lived His life?
4. What gifts has God given you that He might be asking you to use to point others to Him?
5. Read 2 Corinthians 8:9. What does this reveal about the purpose of Jesus' life?
6. Read Luke 19:10. This states Jesus' purpose in different words. What do these two verses reveal about Jesus' personality? What kind of person is He?
7. How do we become servants like Jesus was, as Jesus taught in Matthew 20:25-28? How do we do this in 2015?
8. Reread 2 Corinthians 8:9. How have you been made rich by Jesus?
9. With the riches given to you by Jesus, and the gifts he is given you, what is the best way for you to serve?

Challenge:

- Take this prayer, and write it down on a notecard. Throughout the rest of the week, take it out a couple of times a day and pray through it and think about it:

"God give me an opportunity to use the gifts You've given me for Your Glory, to point people to Your Son Jesus, and for their benefit."
