3. Do you fear death? Why or why not?
4. What comfort does **John 11:25-26** bring you in the face of death and hard times?
5. Do you feel like you have the strength to face all things, even the hard stuff, as stated in **Philippians 4:13**? Why or why not?
6. Do you believe that Jesus is the Christ, and that His death counts for you, and that nothing in this world, not even death, is enough to separate you from Him? Why or why not?

¹The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

²He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters.

³He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name’s sake.
