ICEBREAKER: *What's your go-to drink when you're feeling really thirsty? What's the grossest thing you've ever drank?*

QUESTIONS:

How do you think your soul can be thirsty?

*What do you think that looks like? **Spiritual thirst is the want to see something change in your life.***

Have you ever felt spiritually thirsty? What was that like?

What do you normally do when your soul is thirsty?

When you try to quench your thirst without Jesus, what does that say about the thing you using in the place of Jesus?

Read John 7:37-39

What is confusing about this passage?

What stands out to you?

On a scale of 1-10, one being dehydrated, ten being, "I just drank an entire gallon of water," where would you rate your spiritual thirst?

What kind of decisions do you make when you're spiritually thirsty?

What are things you can do this week to better satisfy your spiritual thirst (to see God change something in your life)?

Challenge: Every day this week you read the verse of the day on the Bible app with your group and pray about the things you need Jesus to satisfy you with and not other things.
