Read: 1 Samuel 17:1-50, 1 Corinthians 9:24-26

David stepped up to the plate when no one else would. He trusted God. David was strong and courageous, and God helped him do an incredible thing. It was probably terrifying to fight Goliath, and David may have even thought he could die, but he was so confident in the big thing God was calling him to do that nothing could stop him.
